

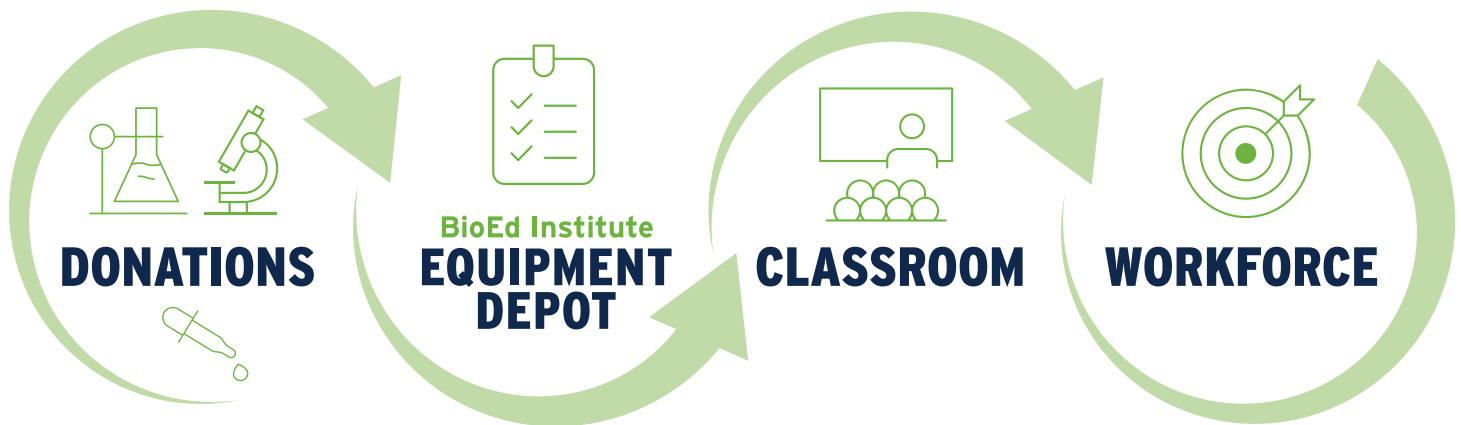
Providing Donated Lab Supplies to Enhance STEM Education in Georgia's Classrooms

HOW DO WE DO IT? The BioEd Institute seeks lightly used, last generation, and surplus equipment, supplies, and consumables from industry. Industry donates goods; we get them into a classroom.

University lab donations have largely supported Equipment Depot inventory.

HIGH NEED ITEMS: Safety goggles, pipette tip boxes (200 μ L or 1000 μ L, with case and insert), Pipettors (can accept broken micropipettes), glassware, plasticware, and plastic petri dishes.



WE ALSO ACCEPT: Accidental orders that can't be returned, gloves, small electronics, and medical supplies (such as blood collection tubes).
